Rapeseed

Rapeseed/Canola is used to produce oil and animal feed and is mainly produced in the European Union, Canada, USA, Australia, China and India.



Mustard Seed

Mustard Seeds can be found in both yellow & black colors. It is a regional food of many countries and is used as a spice in various parts of India and Nepal. Major producers of Rapeseed/Canola are Canada, Nepal, Russia, Ukraine, India, Pakistan and USA.

Soybean Meal

It is used as a source of protein for animals, including Pigs, Chicken, Fish, Cattle and Sheep.

Balanced Soybean Meal

This product is exported mainly out of Argentina, and is a mix of Soybean Meal, Corn and some other materials.

Rapeseed Meal

Rapeseeds contain about 40-46% semi-drying oil, which is used as cooking oil or to manufacture margarine.

Shea Nut Meal

Shea Nut Meal is obtained after the fat extraction of Shea Nuts and is produced in West Africa.

Wheat is used for making various feed ingredient products.

Grains are small, hard and dry seeds harvested for human and animal consumption. There are many different types of Grains that are grown worldwide.

Wheat

Wheat is one of the largest produced cereal grain in the world, with an annual production of about 720 Million tons. Wheat is the leading source of protein in human food, having a higher protein content than many other major cereals. After Rice, wheat is the second-most consumed human food. The top wheat producers are China, India, USA, Russia, France, Canada and Germany.

Corn

Corn/Maize is mainly used as food and starch. Major producers of Maize are USA, China, Brazil, Argentina, Ukraine, India, Mexico, Indonesia, France and South Africa.

Sugar

Sugar is mainly produced from Sugarcane and Sugar Beet. World production of Sugar is at about 170 Million metric tons a year. An average person consumes 25 kg of sugar per year. The major sugar producing countries are Brazil, India, EU, China, Thailand, USA, Mexico, Russia, Pakistan, and Australia.
